

Pursuant to Section 5 of the IPR Policy, SIGIS: Special Interest Group for IAS Standards, Inc. ("Corporation") is providing you with written notice of its intent to adopt the mark: **SIGIS Special Interest Group for IAS Standards** on January 7, 2008 ("Adoption Date"). Should you have any objection to the adoption or use of this mark by the Corporation, as per Section 5.5 of the IPR Policy, you must provide written notice to the Board of Directors of the Corporation prior to the Adoption Date. If you do not provide an objection prior to the Adoption Date, as per the IPR Policy, you have waived any right to bring a claim against the Corporation or any Member or their Affiliates for their use of such mark.

Section 5.5 of the IPR Policy:

"In the event that the Corporation proposed to adopt an initial Corporation name or trademark based on such name for use with any of the Deliverables, the Corporation shall provide Notice to the Members at least 15 days in advance in writing of the proposal. Each Member agrees that unless it provides written Notice to the Board of Directors that Member's challenge the proposed initial Corporation name or trademark based on such name proper to its adoption by the Board of Directors, then the Members and its Affiliates shall not bring a claim against the Corporation or any Member or their Affiliates for their use of such initial Corporation name or trademark based upon such name."
